To show the passage of time, as Gwion stirs the potion, we travel through the four seasons. Ioan introduces us to the Welsh names of each season. But which other Welsh words can we learn?

Step 1: Re-watch [the section](#) of the play again.

Step 2: Ask the children can they find the names of each of the four seasons in Welsh [by listening to Ioan](#).

Step 3: Hand out the four seasons title cards and ask the children to brainstorm 10 ideas for things that represent each season. These can be written or drawn on sugar paper.

Summer	haf	<i>h-arve</i>
Autumn	hydref	<i>hud-rev</i>
Winter	gaeaf	<i>g-aye-ave</i>
Spring	gwanwyn	<i>goo-anne-win</i>

Step 4: Next, hand out the 12 seasonal cards:

“cardiau – c-ar-dee-eye”

Do these match their ideas? Can they place each card in the right season? Do they all agree? Are some true for more than one season?

This could be against the clock or in teams for fun.

Step 5: Learn how to pronounce the 12 new words by following Ioan’s examples here: **CLIP here**.

Step 6: Finally, introduce the children to a simple sentence pattern they might use to discuss the season.

Dwi’n hoffi (*insert feature*) **yn y** (*insert season*) **mae e’n wych!**
