

Agent Briefing: Access

Thank you so much for joining us on this exciting adventure. Here are a few things to be aware of before you start.

We know that all potential agents will be hardy types, but don't fall prey to our brilliantly variable Welsh weather- bring sunscreen and waterproofs.

Remember to bring water.

Please wear sensible footwear.

If you may need to sit down during the route please let us know and we can provide camping style chairs.

We can also move these around the route for you if necessary.

All attempts have been made to ensure that the route is wheelchair accessible. The routes chosen are all step free, but sometimes the weather can make the terrain more difficult. As we have had a lot of rain over the last few weeks there may be some parts of the route that are harder to get around than usual. Please let us know if you think you will need any help.



At Bryn Garw the planned route does include a slope. If this is inaccessible for your group, please let us know and we can give you a different version of the app so that you can do the activities in one place.

If you use a screen reader:

The app we are using has its own screen reader that seems to override other screen readers. Be aware that the app is German made and their reader has a strong German accent which can be difficult to understand at times. This is something we are working on improving at headquarters. All the performance elements of the experience have integrated audio description, but if the inbuilt screen reader is making it harder for you to complete the mission please turn off this function, we will have agents on site who can assist you.
